Policy

The Saskatchewan Polytechnic Students' Association Inc. recognizes the need for materials to be produced or displayed for the purpose of campaigning and such materials must follow the appropriate procedures.

Procedures

1. Campaigning begins the day nominations open. All campaign materials, including electronic materials, must be removed or deleted by 4:00 p.m. the following Monday after Election Day, or in the case of campus closure, the first date after such closure.
2. No printed/posted material shall depict or infer anything offensive or illegal.
3. The political committee will evaluate questionable campaign materials.
4. Usage of official SPSA or Saskatchewan Polytechnic logos is prohibited.
5. All campaign material must be approved by the respective campus' deputy returning officer (DRO) prior to posting.
6. Prior to the elections, only the political committee is authorized to remove campaign materials.
7. All posters must contain an original SPSA approval stamp before posting. Pamphlets do not require a stamp but must be approved prior to distribution.
8. Websites or blogs, which includes but is not limited to, Facebook, Myspace, Hi5, Livejournal, blogspot, etc. are allowed only during the campaign period. A link to any and all electronic campaign tools must be provided to the chief returning officer (CRO). Any postings deemed to be offensive or slanderous may result in candidate disqualification.
